Timing (mins)	Stage Name	Procedure	Stage Aim	Interaction
5 mins	Lead-in	Tell ss that as a class we are going to make a shopping list. Each student must remember the previous items on the list and add a new item. The game is over when a student can't remember the list or can't add a new item. e.g. c.g. T: bananas, S1: bananas, apples, S2: bananas, apples, rice, S3: bananas, apples, rice, pasta, S4: bananas, apples, rice, pasta, tuna etc.	To lead ss into the lesson with a fun activity related to the TL.	S-S
5 mins	Presentation of vocabulary	Upload Material 1 : Types of shops Butchers Bakers Supermarket Post office Pharmacy Newsagent Elicit the names of the shops from the class and items that you would buy from each one. Write these next to each shop.	To introduce students to the TL.	T-S S-T
5 mins	Controlled Practice of vocabulary	Give ss a selection of new items from each shop. Upload Material 2 . Ss complete the activity by matching the objects to the shops. Group feedback.	To provide guided practice of the TL.	S S-T

Timing (mins)	Stage Name	Procedure	Stage Aim	Interaction
5 mins	Presentation of grammar	Write the verb 'go' on the board. Elicit that it's a verb - a doing word. Ask ss: What about 'yesterday'? Do we 'go' yesterday? How can we say this? Upload Material 3 - past of 'go' and 'buy' with a graphic. Demonstrate to the class how the verb changes when it's in the past.	To introduce the two verbs and make ss aware of the past simple verb tense.	T-S S-T T-S
10 mins	Controlled Practice of the grammar	Listening task: T reads the sentences to the class. Ss listen to a selection of sentences and note down what the people bought. (Note: T can pre-record these to make them more authentic and can add more examples as required) I went to the bakers and bought a donut and some bread. I went to the butchers and bought a chicken and some sausages. I went to the supermarket and bought some chips. I bought some medicine from here. Group feedback: Ss tell the class what items they heard in each shop.	Provide further practice with the TL.	T-S S-S
(5 mins)	Filler	Ask ss to write down their own ideas for shops they 'went' to and items they 'bought'. Listen to ss ideas as a group.	An extra activity in case the class is ahead of schedule.	S S-S

Timing (mins)	Stage Name	Procedure	Stage Aim	Interaction
10 mins	Freer Production of TL	Give ss the role play cards (Material 4) and tell them to act out the role play in pairs or as a whole group. Encourage ss to use the TL from the lesson. Write the following sentence starters on the board: • I (don't) want • I (don't) need • Can I have • I would like T corrects errors made in activity at the end.	Provide ss with freer practice of the TL.	S-S T-S
5 mins	Cooler (Anagrams)	Write anagrams of the words covered in this lesson on the board E.g. thcubre = butcher Ss race to solve the anagrams. The first student to finish is the winner.	Recycle vocabulary and close the lesson in a fun manner.	S
